

Notice of Public Comment Period

The Colorado General Assembly enacted legislation, recognizing that mail ballot elections are cost-efficient, which allows each Colorado county to conduct the Primary Election by mail ballot, with service centers located throughout the county.

Before a determination is made how to conduct the Primary Election, the Larimer County Clerk and Recorder will receive written public comment on conducting the Primary Election as a mail ballot election.

Notice is hereby given that the Larimer County Clerk and Recorder will receive written public comment beginning on January 24, 2012 through February 2, 2012 regarding whether or not the 2012 Primary Election shall be conducted by mail ballot, with service centers located throughout the county. Please submit your comment in favor of or opposed to a Primary Election conducted by mail ballot by one of the following means:
