

Entrance Permits

- ▶ Required of all visitors (*including walk-in and bike-in*) at all times
- ▶ Annual Entrance Permits ~ valid for calendar year. Purchase at The Bison Visitor Center, at entrance stations prior to entering the parks and open spaces, at nearby retail outlets, and online at www.larimer.org/naturalresources

Resident Vehicle:	\$ 65
Non-resident Vehicle:	\$ 85
2nd Vehicle:	\$ 40
Resident Boat:	\$ 65
Non-resident Boat:	\$ 85
Senior vehicle:	\$ 35
Paddling:	\$ 35
Disabled:	\$ 10

- ▶ Daily Entrance Permits ~ one for vehicle AND one for boat. Valid day of purchase until noon the next day. Purchase at The Bison Visitor Center, and at entrance stations or self-serve stations prior to entering the parks.

Other areas:	\$ 6/vehicle

- ▶ April ~ September

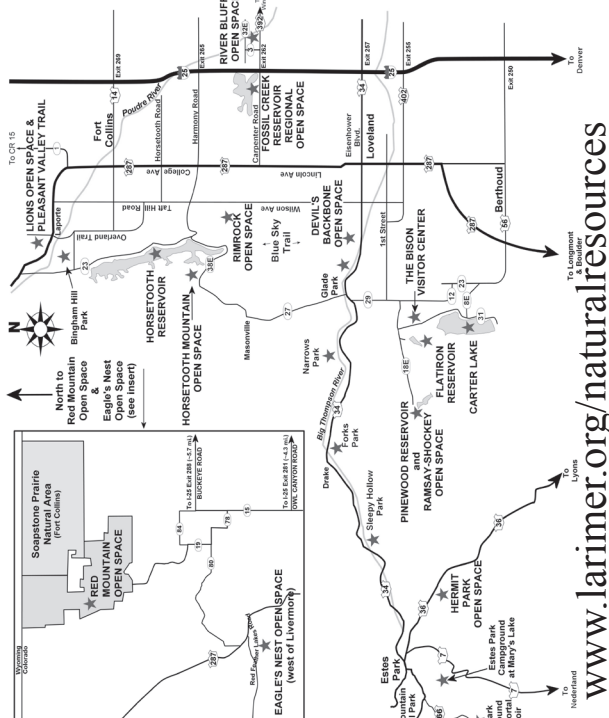

Horsetooth Reservoir County Park

- ▶ Elevation of 5,430 feet
- ▶ 2,040 acres of water + 1,900 acres of public lands
- ▶ 6.5 miles long, 180 feet deep at deepest point
- ▶ Open year round
- ▶ Fishing, boating, camping, picnicking, swimming, water skiing
- ▶ Great fishing ~ walleye, smallmouth bass, perch, trout, and other
- ▶ 7 waterfront cabins available year-round
- ▶ Full service marina (970) 223-0140

Regulations to Help Us Serve You

- ▶ Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
 - ▶ Only 3.2% alcohol is allowed ~ glass is prohibited.
 - ▶ Pets must be leashed at all times (10 ft. max.) and must not be left unattended.
 - ▶ Camping allowed in designated campsites only.
 - ▶ Homeland Security prohibits recreation on dams. Stay 100 feet away from dams when on land ~ no restrictions from water.
