Directions:

The Berthoud Transfer Station is located south of Highway 56 off County Line Road, east of the gun club. Coming from Berthoud, go east on Highway 56 and turn south on County Line Road. Travel about 1/2 mile and turn east on the first gravel road. The transfer station and recycling drop-off are on the south side of the road.

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS:

Rinse. Remove lids (metal lids can be recycled, but must be unattached). Paper labels okay. *No plate glass, drinking glasses, cookware, light bulbs, ceramics, etc.*

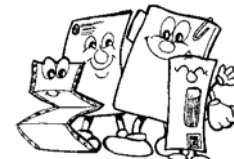
PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Rinse.

Most containers (e.g., bottles, jars, tubs, pails, cups, pots) #1-#7. Snap-on lids okay. *No automotive chemical or pesticide bottles. No microwave trays, party platters, plastic wrap or bags, Styrofoam, or items marked "compostable."*

ALUMINUM & STEEL (TIN)

CANS: Rinse. Don't flatten. Metal lids okay. Labels okay. **EMPTY** aerosol cans okay. Foil and pie plates okay, but must be flat, *not* balled up.

Newspapers PLUS Recycling Bin

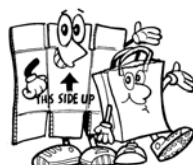


NEWSPAPERS: Includes inserts. *Do not place in plastic bags or secure with string.*

MAGAZINES & CATALOGS: *No glue bindings more than 1/2 inch thick.*

JUNK MAIL: Open and remove non-recyclable items.

PAPER BAGS: Flatten boxes. *No wax-coated boxes.*
